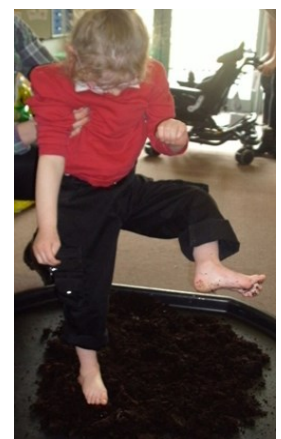

Equipment that can enable a child to go to school, sleep at night free of pain, speak to their parents for the first time or visit grandparents.
