Dear Parents and Carers,

Possible expansion of Baytree Special School onto a new site in Clevedon

As you know Baytree School have been working with N-Somerset Council on the expansion onto a new site providing the appropriate environment for our Children and Young People with the most profound and complex needs.

A report is to be submitted to the CYPS Policy & Scrutiny Committee asking the committee to add their support to a recommendation to Cllr Gibbons, Executive Member for Children & Young People's Services, to enable consultations to commence about the expansion of Baytree School. This will include the creation of a 2nd site for 65 pupils at Brookfield Walk in Clevedon.

At this stage no decisions about the future of the site have been taken. This letter is to advise you that N-Somerset are seeking permission to be able to consult with stakeholders about possible changes in relation to locating new school buildings on this land.

If the consultations go favourably and plans for the expansion of Baytree School move forward then parents and carers will have the opportunity to contribute ideas to this exciting development.
