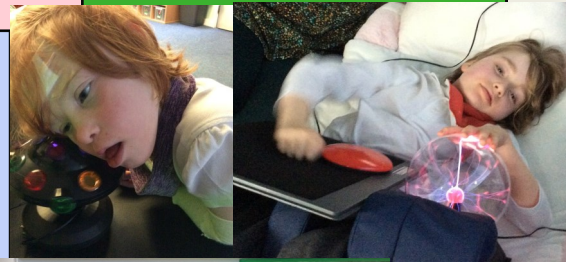
We are always extremely grateful for any donations and this has given us a great start towards our latest project.

In PSHE we have been looking at ways to take care of ourselves and there was some fantastic engagement with the hand washing lesson.

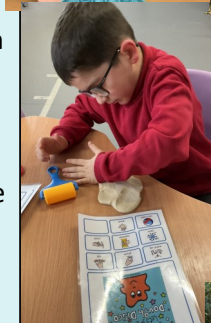
