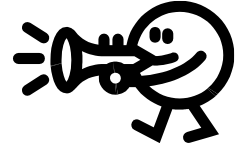

**Green Class** has had lots of fun this term. We have especially enjoyed our Sensory Stories with things to press, items to hold and fun to be had - by all!



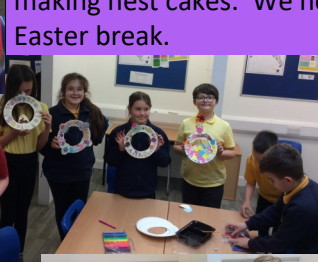
