It has been wonderful to see all our learners happily return to school and I have been particularly impressed with how well all our new learners have settled in.

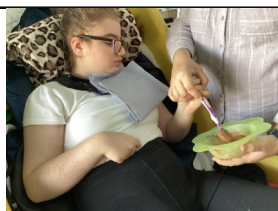

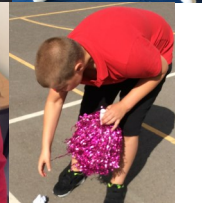
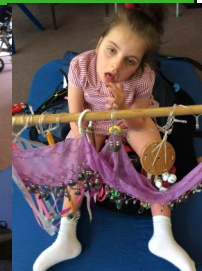


In **Orange class** we have been welcoming our new friends in class and having fun exploring circles. Hello to Jude. Hello to Finley. Hello to Tayla.
