

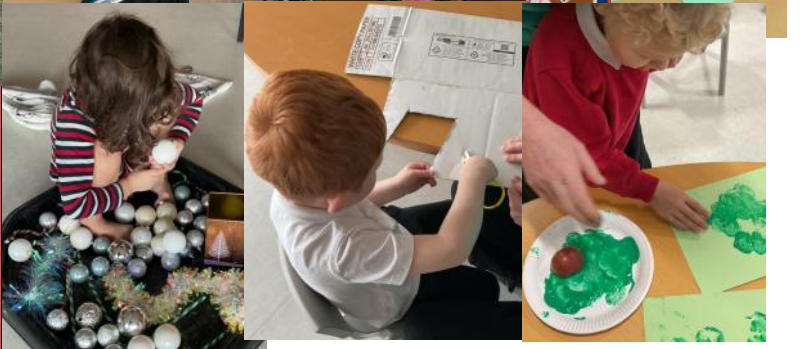

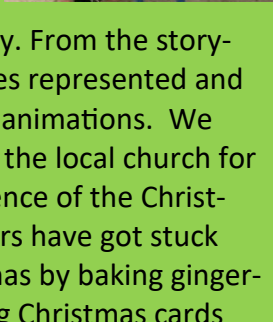

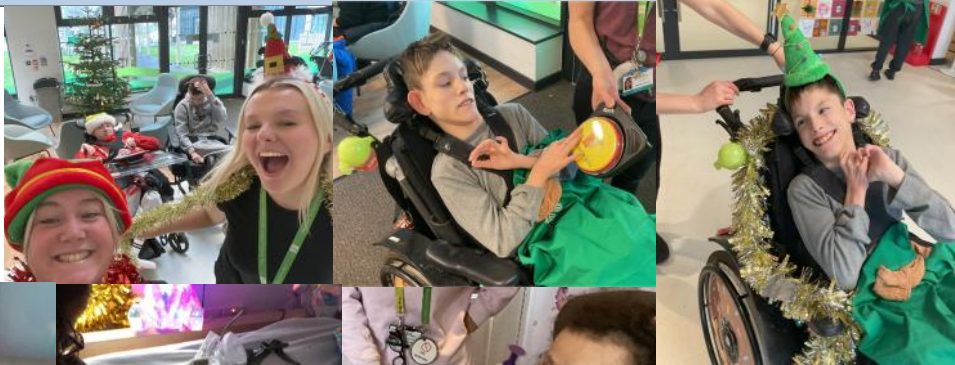

Tickenham & The Pier, Clevedon

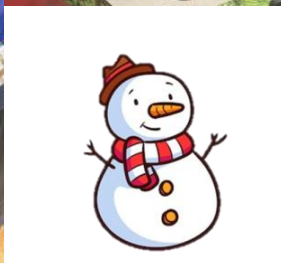

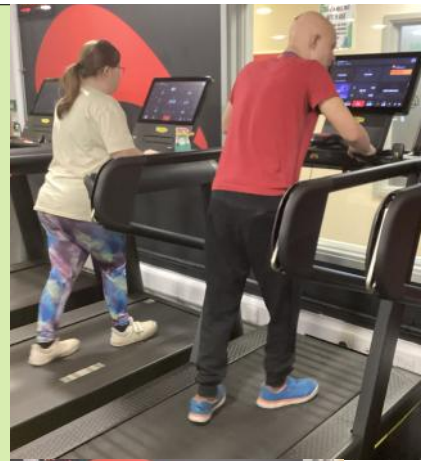

Yellow Class, Weston - have been having so much Christmassy fun!



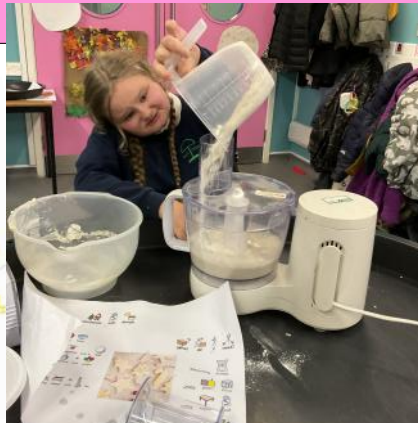
