We have also been making the most of the sunny weather by getting out and about, including a walk to the local pond and a trip to the shops/costa.

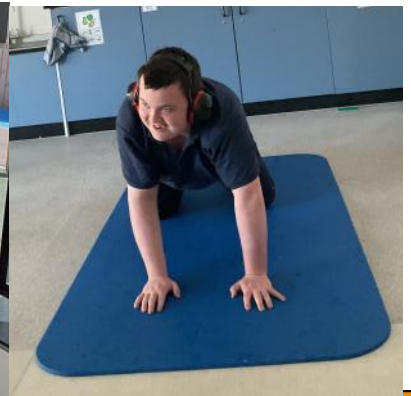
We want to say a huge congratulations to Georgia, our TA, who completed the London marathon, raising a huge amount of money for the charity Sense. Well done Georgia!

Pink Class, Weston - Buckle up, parents! Pink Class has officially exited Earth's orbit as we launch into our stellar new topic: The Big Bang. It has been an out-of-this-world start to the term, and the energy in the room is high enough to power a rocket ship. We've been busy exploring the gigantic sphere of space, and the children have truly embraced their new roles as cosmic explorers. We didn't just read about space; we moved into it. We have had a fantastic time simulating space - exploring what it actually feels like to leave the atmosphere, training like astronauts and visualising the vastness of our universe and how it all began.



The highlight of our week has been the start of our collaborative creative story. We are co-writing an epic space adventure, and the imagination on display is breath taking. So far, our brave astronauts have: ignited the engines and felt the rumble of a heavy lift-off, navigated the stars, using sensory language to describe the darkness and twinkling diamonds of the cosmos. The children are currently mid-flight, peering through the portholes and wondering what—or who—awaits them.



The Pier, Clevedon - We've had a lovely first two weeks back! We've soaked up the sun this week and enjoyed the playground with our other upper school friends. We've enjoyed being out in the community around the local cafes and shops. We've also been preparing for our spring market stool which we will be setting up in the next few weeks. Well done pier!



Purple Class, Clevedon - have launched into Term 5 with an exciting "Out of This World" theme, sparking curiosity and imagination across our learning. In Literacy, we are diving into space-inspired stories, where children are engaging with rich sensory storytelling, exploring textures, sounds, and visuals that bring planets, stars, and astronauts to life. These immersive experiences are nurturing communication, creativity, and a growing love of books. In Maths, we are exploring the concept of space in a different way; thinking about shape, position, and how objects move and fit together through hands-on, playful activities. Our learning is extending beyond the classroom too, as we take our space theme outdoors, children are creating beautiful star constellations and shimmering sun catchers, as well as designing their own telescopes to explore the world around them. It's been a fantastic, imaginative start, with curiosity soaring as high as the rockets we are sending into the sky!

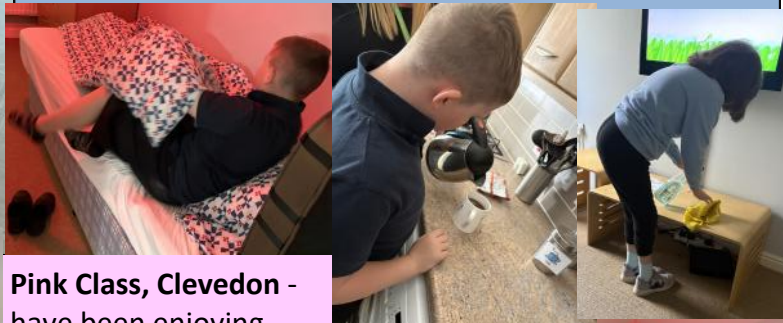
