Finally, we revisited the stories we wrote last week to add musical elements, carefully considering which sounds would best replicate the different stages of our journey.

Everyone loved dressing up as astronauts, blasting off on imaginative space adventures and experiencing the movement of rockets through a range of sensory and interactive activities. 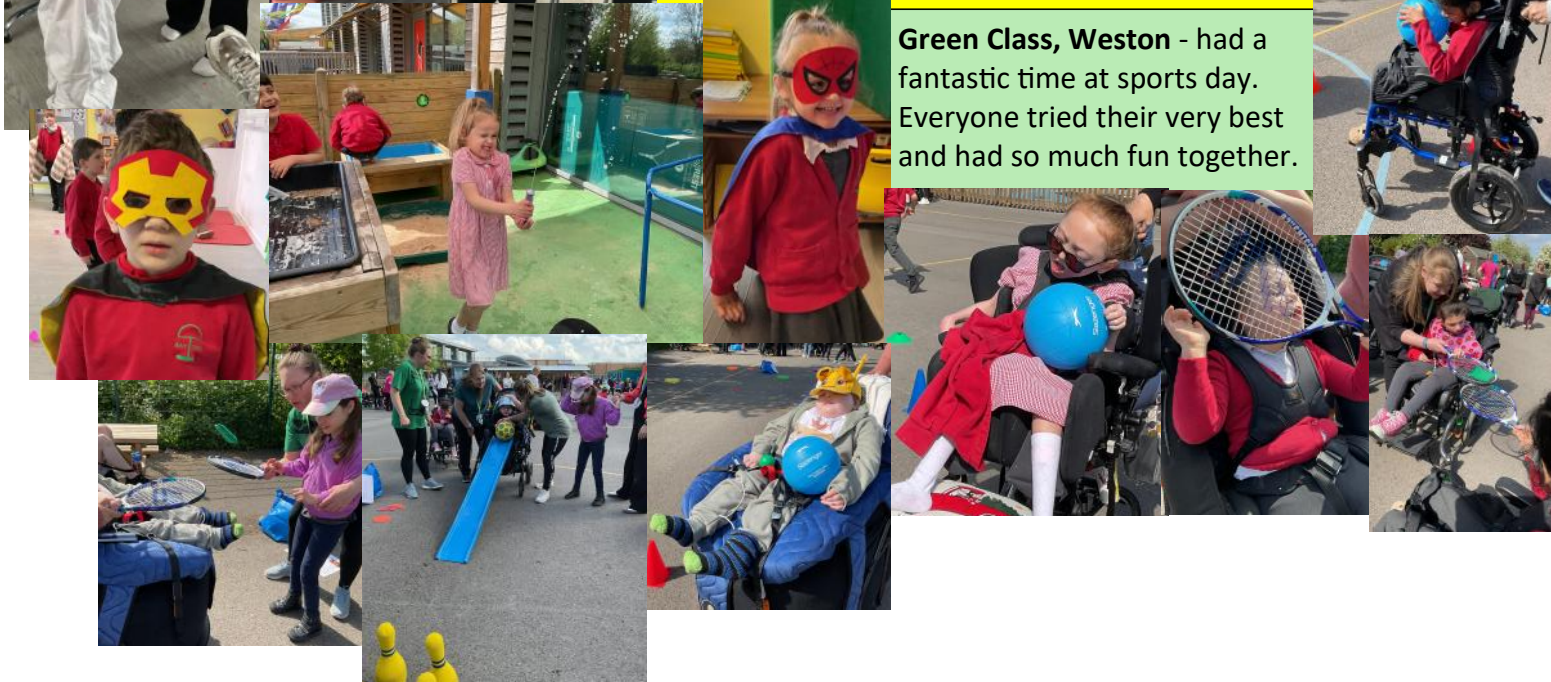

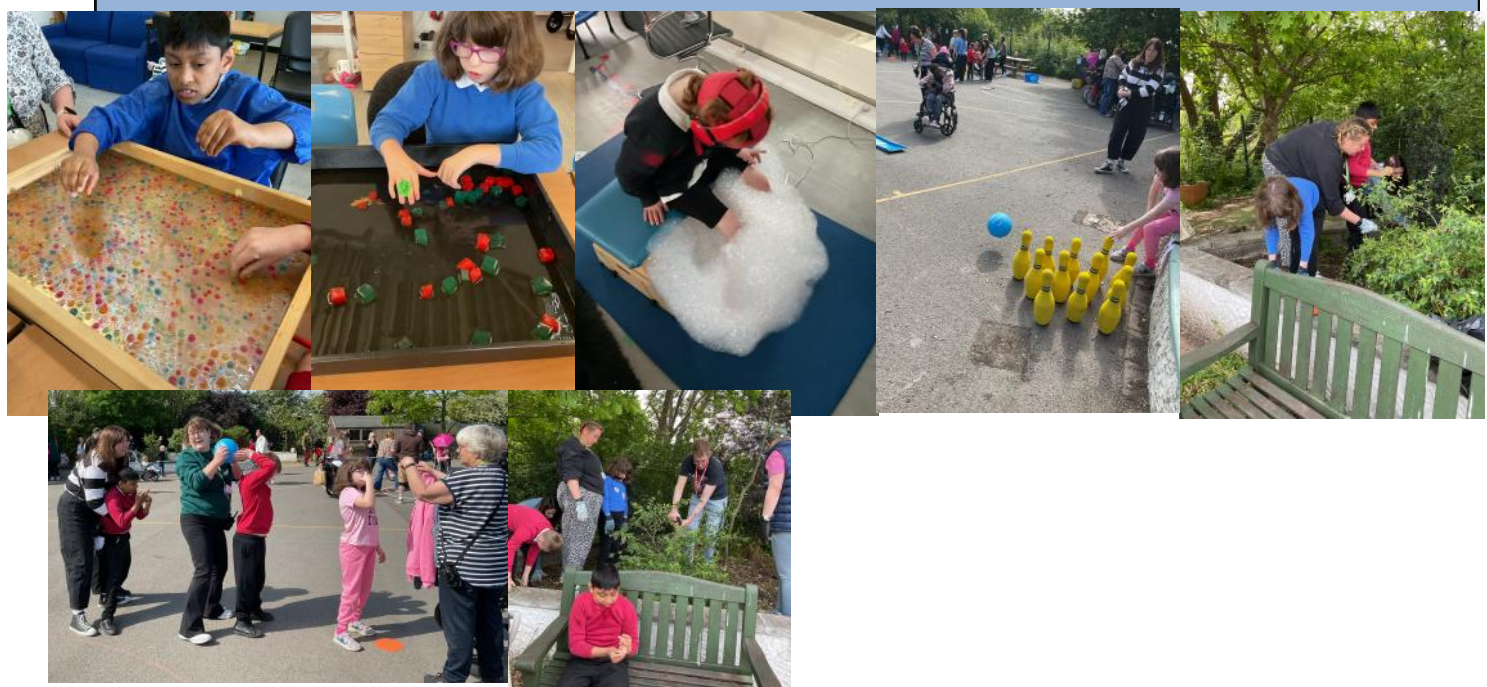

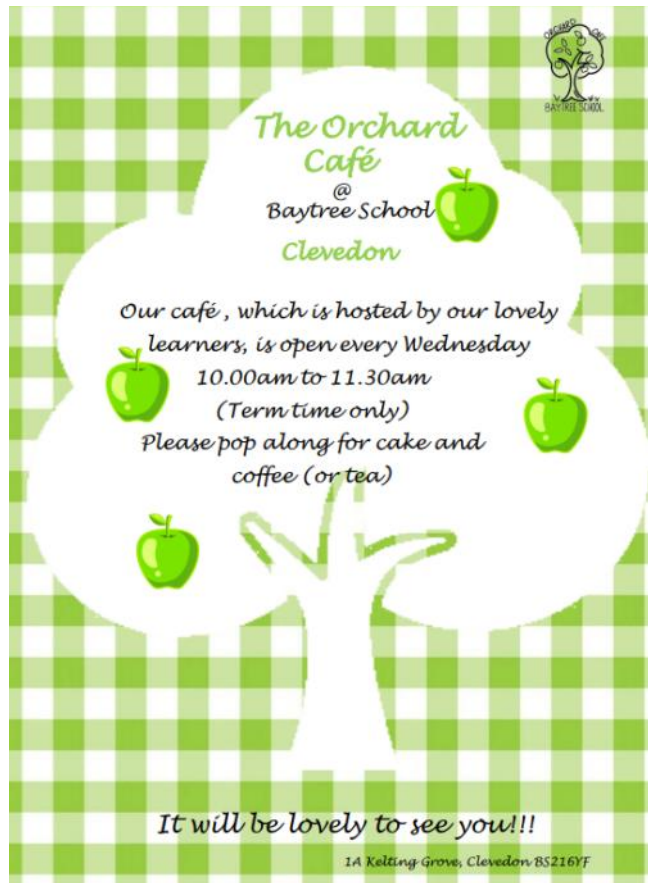
